## Your business:

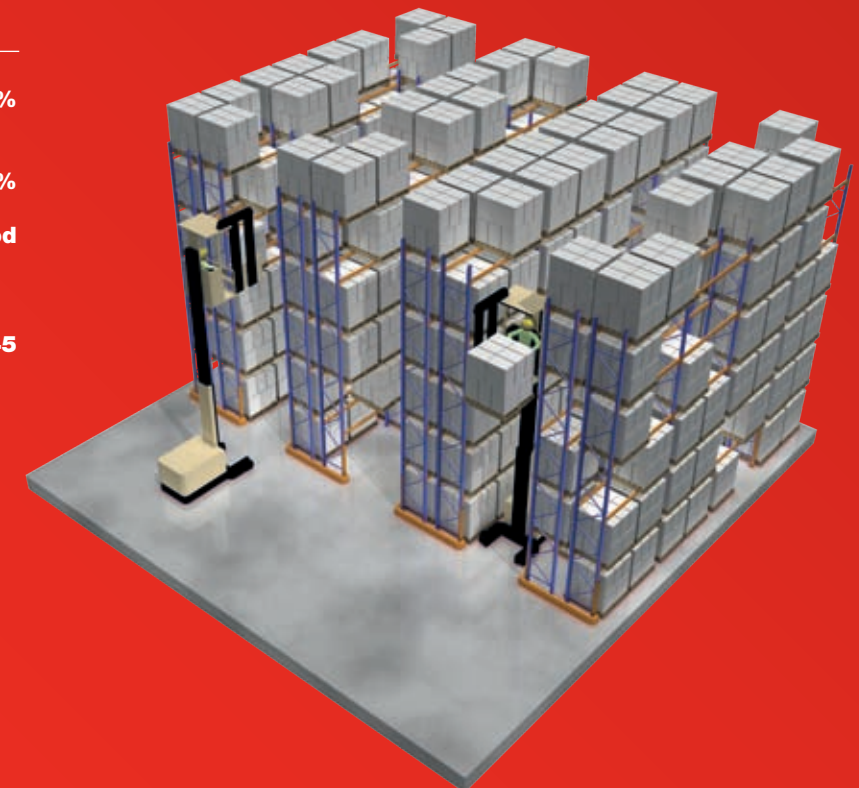
You require greater storage density, your orders are complex and varied. Turnaround times are not critical, however you require immediate access to all products. Space in your facility is at a premium, so you're keen to get the most from what you've got.

## Our solution:

Narrow aisle racking, as the name suggests, makes optimal use of floor area and roof height. Direct access to every pallet is achieved. The system is serviced by special forklift trucks. Operating cabins may be elevating or static.

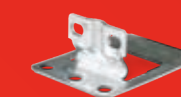

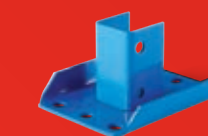

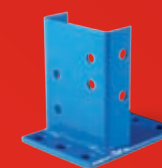
